SUPPORT FOR FAMILIES

Strengthening Parental Relationships

Strengthening Parental Relationships (SPR) is Hampshire's Reducing Parental Conflict offer, a government-funded programme which aims to support parents and carers with their relationship. Some level of arguing and conflict between parents is often a normal part of everyday life. However, there is strong evidence to show how interparental conflict that is frequent, intense and poorly resolved can have a significant negative impact on children's mental health and long-term life chances. Hampshire County Council have procured a limited number of spaces for Mediation/Couple Support and Family Counselling. This service is for families who are experiencing harmful parental conflict and require high intensity, expert provision. This service is available to families from across Hampshire County Council area. This service is for families where the parents/carers are experiencing parental conflict that is frequent, intense and poorly resolved. They may have already tried the Free online courses for parents/carers experiencing relationship distress. Please contact us if you would like to find out more.
