

Maths

In Maths, we are focusing on fractions: recognising and finding $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{3}{4}$, unit fractions, finding the whole from a fraction and non unit fractions. We will then move on to revisiting time and learning about o'clock, half-pasts, before looking at telling the time to 5 minutes, minutes in an hour and hours in a day.



Art This project teaches children about the visual elements of flowers, including shape, texture, colour, pattern and form. They also explore various artistic methods, including drawing, printmaking and 3-D forms, using paper and clay.

P.E.

Indoor P.E. Dance – we will focus mirroring each other.

Outdoor P.E. Continuing to work with Coach Toby to develop coordination and an understanding of how to play netball and basket.



Science - Plants

The children will build upon their learning in previous units. Children will be learning about the different parts of a plant, about growth from seeds to bulb identifying what a plant needs to grow and stay healthy, as well as carrying out an observation over time.

Second Half Spring Term Year 2 Topic Web

R.E. This term we are deepening our understanding of God. We are looking at the story of Jonah and the Whale. We will be looking at how we can see God in the story and the different qualities of God.

Music

The children will be using our new scheme, 'Sing Up' to develop their musical awareness and understanding.

ICT

We will use Purple Mash to developing our skills with using computers to produce Art.

English

Our first unit is linked to the text the Dragon Machine by Helen Ward. Children will be learning to plan and write their own version of a dragon story. This unit includes looking at the suffixes -ed, -ness and -ment. We will also be looking at noun phrases, adverbs and conjunctions. Our next unit is based on Oceans Meet Sky. Children will be writing their own fantasy narrative.

Geography – Comparing Yateley to Silvapura in India

The children will develop their understanding of the Geography by learning about the physical and human features of two different places, the climate, weather and making comparisons between the two.

PSHE – Relationships

In this unit the children will consider what makes a family and the different types of families. They will look at relationships within their families, with their friends, with their classmates and with themselves.
